Kayaking at the Panama Canal's Chagres River

Tour Highlights:

Kayak the historic Chagres River, where hundreds of "49ers" floated on their way to California during the Gold Rush. Dramatic rainforest scenery and lush aquatic vegetation combine with the raucous calls of water birds. Close to the shore's edge, observe toucans feeding in a forest tree or iguanas sunning themselves high in the canopy. Regardless of the time of year, tropical waters are a comfortable temperature.
